The purpose of the **Component 1 – Workshop 2 - Part 2** is to present and discuss the results achieved by the Consultant related to Module 4, with the GMS Counterparts.

Module 4 consists of **five (5) Tasks** as follows:

- **Task 1:** Data Collection
- **Task 2:** Review and assessment of the current regulatory framework – Identification of barriers and recommendations
- **Task 3:** Review of International Experiences
- **Task 4:** Conceptual Design of the GMS Regional Electricity Market
- **Task 5:** Completion of the GMS Transmission Regulations

In the framework of **Component 1 – Workshop 2 - Part 2 – Module 4**, the Consultant will present the prerequisites and organization of a modern and efficient Electricity Market, the "Basic Principles" to be applied and the lessons to be learnt from International Experiences such as the European Continental Electricity Market, the Nordic Market and the North American Market (**Task 3**).

The presentation of the Basic Principles for establishing a modern and efficient Electricity Market, illustrated with the international experiences, will prepare the ground to the next workshop, **Component 1 – Workshop 3 - Module 4** (planned in November 2009), which will present the results of **Task 1** and **Task 2**, and will present the first recommendations on the proposed conceptual design for the GMS Regional Electricity market (**Task 4**).

Considering the results to be achieved during the **Component 1 – Workshop 2 - Part 2 – Module 4**, the Consultant highly recommends that the **Participants** to the Workshop should be at **High Decision-Making Level** in the field of **Institutional, Regulatory** and **Commercial** Aspects.
